Why is the Surcharge Sticking Around?

The district conducted a rate study in 2022 and found that a rate increase was crucial and beyond due.

In order to continue to provide safe, high quality water services to the community of Leavitt Lake, a rate increase was necessary.

“We’ve charged too little for too long for water. Our infrastructure is degrading and at the end of its useful life.”

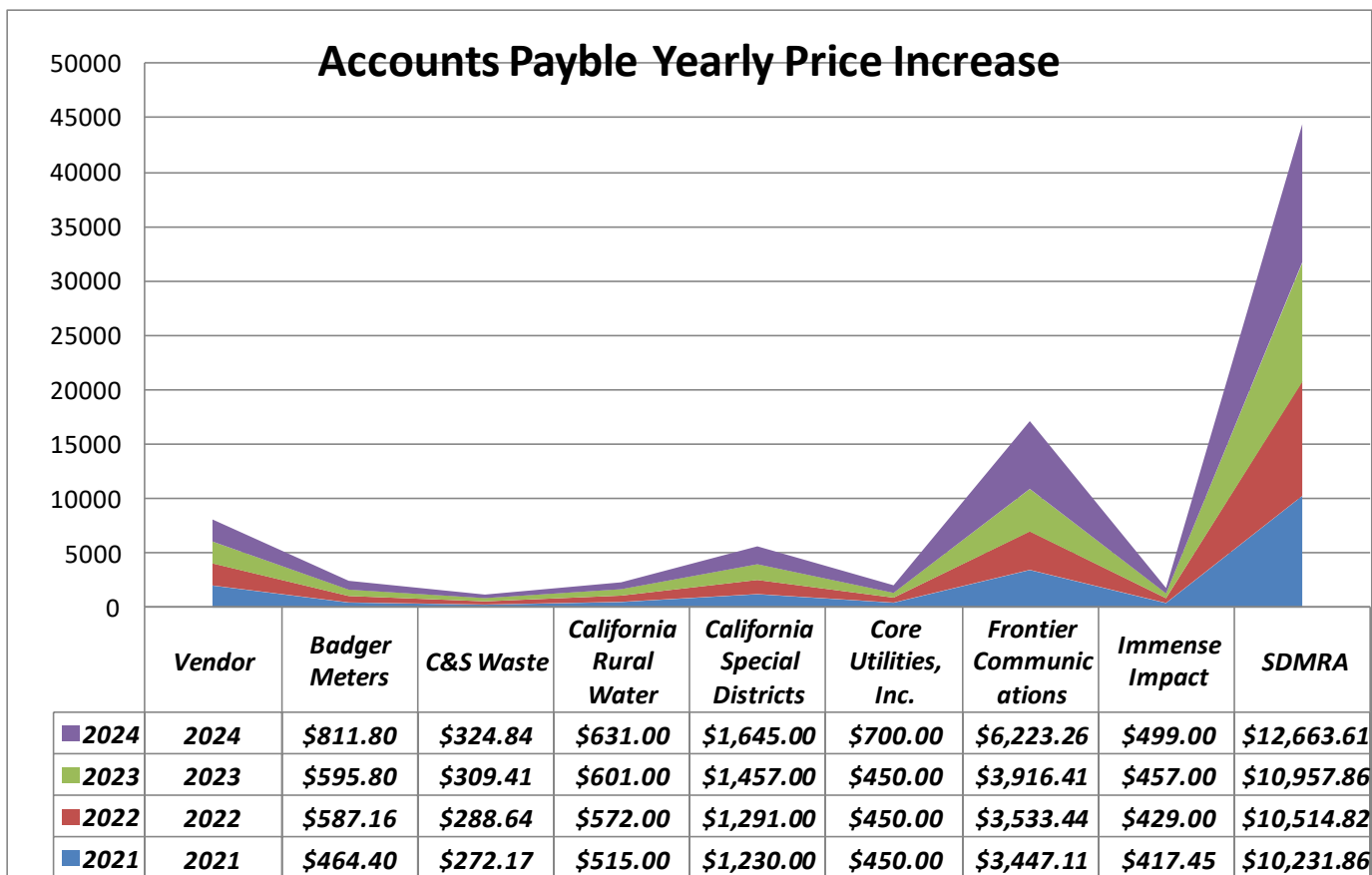

A 5 Year, 5% each year was proposed approved and passed and in January 2023 the community saw the new rate. As the district continued to be impacted by the economy and inflation continued to rise, the need to increase revenue was imperative.

The surcharge was passed by the board of directors in 2023 as a temporary solution to rectify the district crippling deficit.

The board has reviewed the surcharge periodically and has determined the revenue from this fee is needed to provide continued service to the entire community now and in the future, both economically and without interruptions.

FOUR YEAR EXPENDITURE INCREASE COMPARISON
