With project plans moving forward, we expect to see construction begin soon.

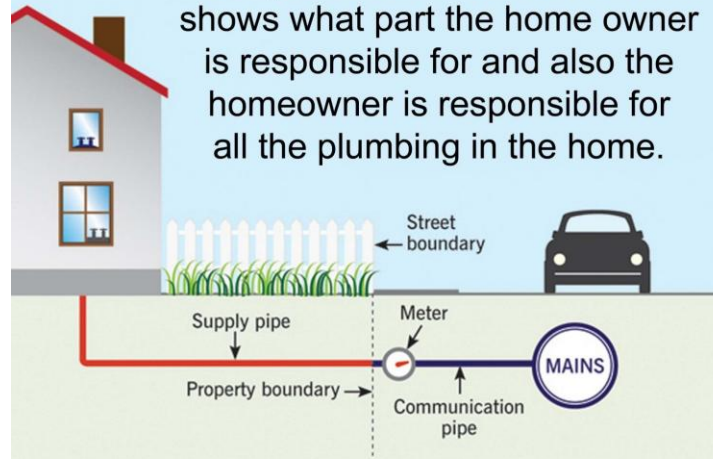

Water Leaks in Your Home Who's Responsible?

The blue line shows what part of the main water line the District is responsible for. The red line shows what part the home owner is responsible for and also the homeowner is responsible for all the plumbing in the home.



Did you know?

Leavitt Lake's metering infrastructure provides information about our customer's water consumption. Using this information, the District is able to detect non-stop, 24/7 water use and to notify customers that they may have a plumbing or irrigation leak, depending on the contact information we have on file in our billing system.
