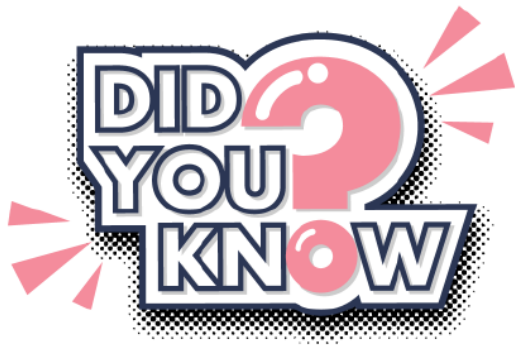

Rate REMINDER

Please be reminded that updated utility rates for Leavitt Lake Community Services will go into effect on January 31, 2026. These adjustments are necessary to help maintain and operate our community services.

Effective 1/31/2026, the rates will be as follows:

- Water Base Rate: \$51.15
- Sewer Base Rate: \$54.26
- Street Lights: \$2.21
- Park Fee: \$3.35
- Meter Fee: \$6.38
- Surcharge: \$10.00 (no change)
- Total: \$127.36 for base rate with no late fee.
