When a Water Line Breaks

Sometimes we have water lines break. In order for the district to repair those lines we first must call USA to dig.

They tell us when we can begin the repairs, which is after the electric company, the cable company and the phone company has marked where their lines are located.

It can take up to three or four days for the process to be completed in order for us to be able to repair the line.

We monitor the break and the water being lost very closely until we are able to make repairs. When making the repairs we most often will have to turn the water off in certain sections. Once the repairs are made, we always ask that the customers -that did have their water shut off, to allow it to run for a few minutes before using.
