Construction to Begin

Construction on the new lift station on Tamarack is to begin in August.

The new lift station will also be equipped with a generator so that when the power goes out, we can still pump the sewage.

They will also begin the work in the pond area. They will be connecting the seven ponds together to work in a series instead of two sets of ponds. And they will be installing a bar screen to remove some of the solids before they go to the ponds.

If we have enough funding, then they will also work on the levee's as some have

eroded over the years.

We have been working towards having the pond work completed for a few years now. While it has taken some time, it will be well worth it in the end.

We will also be having our own storage building built here at the office. It will be a 40X30 metal building that the equipment will be stored in. We will then be giving up the fire hall building.

The funding for these projects is from the County Grant and totals \$747,000.00.
