## NEW RATES GO INTO EFFECT 12/1/18

The new rates will go into effect on December 1, 2018.

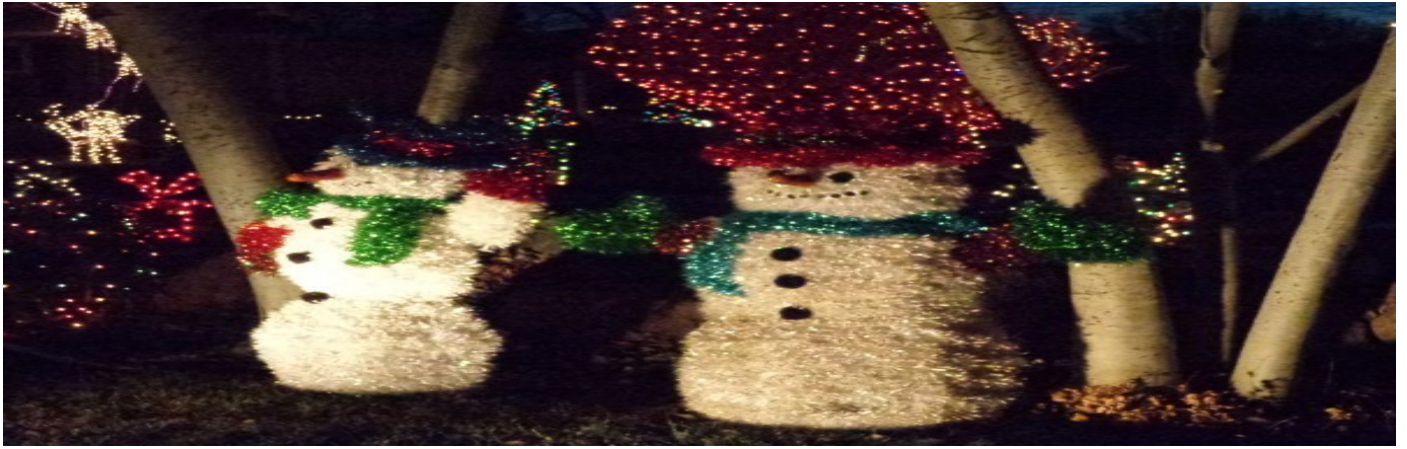
The water base rate will be \$42.08 for 10,000 gallons of water. The meter fee will be \$5.25. For

usage of 10,000 to 12,000 gallons will be charged \$.60 per thousand gallons.

For usage of 12,000 to 14,000 the charge will be \$.80 per thousand and for usage

over 14,000 gallons the charge will be \$1.00 per thousand gallons. The new sewer rate is \$44.64, park \$2.76 and street lights is \$1.82.

Your total bill will be \$96.55 if you do not use more than the 10,000 gallons of water.
