Avoid a Late Fee

Monthly bills go out the last week of each month. These are due by the 18th of the month. The morning of the 19th a late fee of 10% is added and a disconnection notice is sent out.

Please pay your bill by the 18th to avoid added charges.

RATE INCREASE APPROVED

At the October board meeting, a rate increase was discussed at length. All of the district's costs to operate have increased on an average of 9.4%. State mandated costs have all increased again, too. These are costs that the State controls.

While the board did not want to raise the rates, there really isn't any other option. The District has absorbed these increases for a year now and simply cannot continue to do so.

After reviewing all the information, the board voted to approve the rate increase. The increase will be 5%. While this increase will not completely offset the operational increases it will help immensely. The new rates will go into effect on December 1, 2018.

The water base rate will be \$42.08, the meter fee is \$5.25. The sewer rate will be \$44.64, the street lights \$1.82 and the park maintenance will be \$2.76.

The usage rates will be: 10,000 to 12,000 gallons \$.60 per thousand gallons, for 12,000 to 14,000 gallons \$.80 per thousand gallons and for any usage over 14,000 gallons it will be \$1.00 per thousand gallons. The total bill, if no more than 10,000 gallons is used will be \$96.55. If you have any questions, please contact the office at (530) 257-7977.

ERROR ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018 BALLOT

An error was made in the instructions on the November 6, 2018 Statewide General Election ballot for the race of Lassen Community College, Governing Board Member for Trustee Area No. 1. The instructions for this race read, "Vote for no more than THREE" when they should have read, "Vote for no more than TWO".

After Consultations be-

tween the Lassen County Clerk-Recorder, the California Secretary of State's office, Lassen County Counsel and reviewing the California Elections Code it was clear that continuing the elections for this race would produce illegal results. Therefore, due to the error this race must be re-conducted. Votes cast for this race on November 6 will not be tallied.
