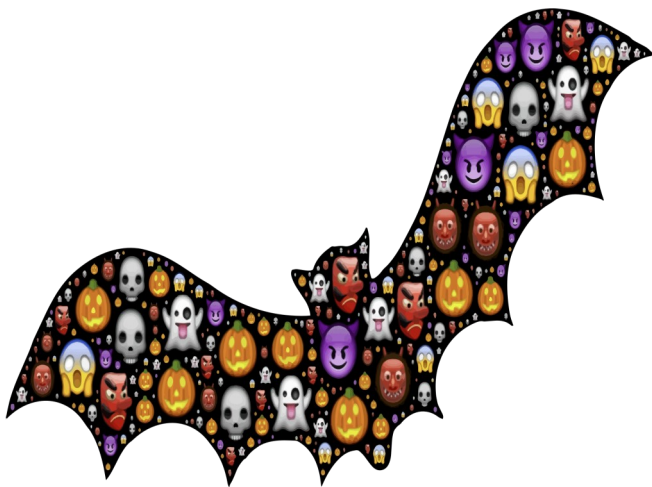
## DISTRICT'S OPERATION COSTS RISING

Each year as a service of Northeastern Rural Health Clinic a women's health screening is held.

This year it will be October 22nd, 29th 30th with Erica Costello PA-C and on October 25th or 26th with Naomi Rea FNP, CNM.

Physical exam includes, pap, urine dip, breast exam, review of labs and

health education.

Exam without insurance is \$132.50 . Exam with insurance and eligible for annual physical \$32.50. No insurance and eligible for sliding fee—sliding fee plus \$32.50 payable at the lab draw appointment.
